**SUBJECT:** Parents of Clara Cowles of Suffield, Connecticut, who married Richard Whitney Loomis and died in the 1960s.

**BACKGROUND SUMMARY:** The Client stated that her great-grandmother was Clara Cowles who married Richard Whitney Loomis and lived in Suffield, Connecticut until she died in the 1960s.<sup>1</sup> The family does not have any further information about Clara's origins but believes she was likely from Suffield or a surrounding town. Client's family seeks to learn the identity of Clara's parents with the goal of developing their family story for this branch of their tree.

**OBJECTIVE:** Identify the parents of Clara Cowles who died in the 1960s and was the wife of Richard Whitney Loomis, of Suffield, Connecticut.

**RESTRICTIONS:** 20 hours *pro bono* for research and reporting. DNA is not available. Repository closures due to COVID-19 and building renovations may limit availability of certain records. Expenses for this project will not be billed to the Client.

## **SUMMARY OF FINDINGS**

The research objective for this session has been successfully met. The parents of Clara Cowles, wife of Richard Whitney Loomis, who lived in Suffield and died in the 1960s, were Henry Stephen Cowles and Clara Rising Austin, both of Suffield, Connecticut.

The following evidence support Henry S. Cowles and Clara R. Austin as the parents of Clara Cowles:

- The birth record of Clara Eloise Cowles born 16 March 1883 names her parents as Henry S. Cowles and Clara R. Austin.<sup>2</sup>
- In 1900, Clara was enumerated as an 18-year-old daughter in the enumeration of the household of Henry S. and Clarissa R. Cowles.<sup>3</sup>
- The marriage record of Clara Louise Cowles to Richard Whitney Loomis names her as the daughter of Henry S. Cowles and Clara R. Austin.<sup>4</sup>
- The obituary of Henry S. Cowles in the trade magazine *The Packages* names his daughter Clara Cowles.<sup>5</sup>
- The obituary of Henry S. Cowles in the Springfield Republican names his daughter Clara Louisa.<sup>6</sup>
- In 1910, Clara L. Cowles was living in the household headed by her brother Frank. Also in the household were his brother Albert B. and mother, Clara Cowles.<sup>7</sup>
- Mrs. Richard Loomis (daughter) is named as the informant on the death certificate of Clara (Austin) Cowles in May 1945.<sup>8</sup>
- The obituary of Clara A. Cowles lists her daughter Mrs. Richard W. Loomis.<sup>9</sup>
- A newspaper article about the 50<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary of Richard W. Loomis and Clara Cowles states that they were married at the home of her mother, Mrs. Henry Cowles. <sup>10</sup>

- The death certificate of Clara Cowles Loomis, dated 22 June 1966, names her parents as Henry Cowles and Clara Austin, both of Suffield, and provides a birthdate of 16 March 1883.<sup>11</sup>
- The obituary of Mrs. Richard Loomis names her as the daughter of Henry S. and Clara (Austin) Loomis. <sup>12</sup>
- The published family history *Genealogy of the Cowles Families in America* names Henry Stephen Cowles and Clara Rising Austin as the parents of Clara Louisa, born 16 March 1883.<sup>13</sup>
- The published family history *The King Family of Suffield, Connecticut, its English Ancestry A.D. 1389-1662 and American Descendants A.D. 1662-1908* names Henry S. Cowles and Clarissa K. Austin as the parents of Clara Louisa, born 16 March 1883.<sup>14</sup>

Clara's father Henry S. Cowles can be uniquely identified as Henry Stephen Cowles, born 02 March 1837 or 1838, son of Stephen Cowles and Thankful Hatheway.

- The family entry of vital information in Suffield town records for Henry S. Cowles names his parents as Stephen Cowles and Thankful Hatheway and provides a birthdate of 02 March 1838.<sup>15</sup>
- Henry Cowles' death certificate provides a birthdate of 02 March 1837 and names his parents as Stephen Cowles and Thankful Hatheway.<sup>16</sup>
- Henry S. Cowles was 13 years old when he was enumerated in the household of Stephen and Thankful Cowles in 1850.<sup>17</sup>
- In 1860, Henry S. Cowles was a 22-year-old trader living in the household of Steven and Thankful Cowles.<sup>18</sup>
- In 1870, Henry S. Cowles, age 32, and Clara Cowles, age 23, were enumerated in the household of Stephen and Thankful Cowles in Suffield.<sup>19</sup>

- The obituary for Henry S. Cowles in *The Packages* provides a date of birth of 02 March 1837 but does not name his parents.<sup>20</sup>
- The obituary for Henry S. Cowles in the *Springfield Republican* provides a birthdate of 02 March 1837 and names his parents as Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Cowles.
- The published family history Genealogy of the Cowles Families in America names Henry Stephen Cowles as the son of Stephen, born 02 March 1838, probably in Suffield.<sup>21</sup>

Clara's mother Clara Austin can be uniquely identified as Clara Rising Austin, also called Clarissa K. Austin, born 25 April 1847, daughter of Thomas C. Austin and Harriet Hatheway.

- The family entry of vital information in Suffield town records for Clarissa K. Austin names her parents, Thomas Cornelius Austin and Harriet Hatheway, and provides a birthdate of 25 April 1847.<sup>22</sup>
- In 1850, 2-year-old Clarissa was enumerated in the household of Thomas C. and Harriet Austin.<sup>23</sup>
- Clarissa R. Austin, age 13, was enumerated in the household of Thomas C. and Harriet Austin in 1860.<sup>24</sup>
- Clara (Austin) Cowles' death certificate provides a birthdate of 25 April 1847 and names her parents, Thomas C. Austin and Harriet Hatheway.<sup>25</sup>
- The obituary for Clara L. Cowles in the Springfield Republican provides a birthdate of 25 April 1847 and names her parents as Thomas C. and Harriet (Hatheway) Austin.<sup>26</sup>

ANALYSIS: The death certificate of Clara Cowles Loomis, wife of Richard Whitney Loomis, indicates that she died in West Suffield, Connecticut, on 22 June 1966. Both the name of her husband and the decade of her death align with the information identified in the Background Summary of this report.

Clara's death certificate names her parents as Henry Cowles and Clara Austin. The Clara named in this certificate was said to have been born on 16 March 1883 in Suffield, Connecticut.

ANALYSIS: The marriage record of Richard Whitney Loomis and Clara Louise Cowles, dated 26 April 1911, identifies Clara's parents as Henry S. Cowles and Clara R. Austin. The Clara identified in this record is tied in as the correct subject of the research because the record shows her marrying the same man known to the Client's family and who appears on her death record.<sup>29</sup> Clara was 27 at the time of her marriage in 1911, which correlates to a birth date in 1883 or 1884.

ANALYSIS: The birth record for Clara Eloise Cowles in the town of Suffield identifies her parents as Henry S. Cowles and Clara R. Austin, both born in Connecticut. The names of Clara's parents

correlate with the names provided on her marriage entry in the Suffield town records.<sup>30</sup> At the time of Clara's birth on 16 March 1883, Clara was age 34 and Henry was age 45. The birth date and place of birth correlate with the information provided in Clara's marriage record in 1911 and her death certificate in 1966.<sup>31</sup> Her parents' names also match the names provided on her death certificate.<sup>32</sup>

ANALYSIS: The death record of Clara Austin Cowles identifies her as the widower of Henry S. Cowles.<sup>33</sup> This document identifies Clara's date of birth as 25 April 1847, which correlates reasonably well but not perfectly with her listed age of 34 on 16 March 1883, her daughter's date of birth.<sup>34</sup> The informant on this certificate is Mrs. Richard Loomis and she is identified as the daughter of the deceased, providing further evidence that the record is for the correct individual. Of note, Clara lived to be 98 years old.

ANALYSIS: This death certificate of Henry Stephen Cowles lists his birth date as 02 March 1837. This correlates to within one year of the age listed for Henry S. Cowles, father of Clara Eloise born in 1883, on her birth record.

ANALYSIS: Clarissa K. Austin is listed as the first child of Thomas Cornelius Austin and Harriet Hatheway, born 25 April 1847. Although this is an official record of the Town of Suffield, it was not created at the time of the event. The children in the family were born across a twenty-two year span and all of the entries appear to have been created at the same time. While it's possible that Thomas or Harriet reported the births of their children, the informant is indeterminable.

ANALYSIS: The 1900 census provides a unique opportunity to compare birth months in addition to birth years. Henry S. Cowles was born March 1838 and Clara R. Cowles, his wife, was born April 1848. The birth months align with the information provided in each of their death certificates, but the year for Clara is provided as one year later.<sup>43</sup> Henry's death certificate indicates 2 March 1837 and Clara's indicates 25 April 1847.<sup>44</sup> Henry was a cigar box manufacturer.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: All members of the household in 1880 were single except for Henry S. and Clara R. Cowles, who were each noted with a tick mark as married.<sup>46</sup>

ANALYSIS: Henry Cowles and Clara Cowles were living with their daughter Jennie E. and their sons, George, Albert B., and Frank, as well as a boarder named Helen S. McClellan. Henry was 43 years old and Clara was 33 years old. Since this census was enumerated on 1 June 1880, Henry and Clara

ANALYSIS: The 1850 census shows Henry S., age 13, in the home of his parents, Stephen and Thankful Cowles.<sup>52</sup> Other members of the household included E.H. Cowles, Elisabeth B. Cowles, Frank Cowles, Mary Broman, and Thankful Hatheway. Of note, Henry attended school during the year and Mary did not, despite being the same age. Based on that fact and her different surname, it is likely that Mary was either a lodger or domestic help. Because there are no younger children, her placement in the order of enumeration is not particularly helpful.<sup>53</sup>

Analysis: In 1860, Clarissa R. Austin, age 13, was enumerated as the oldest of five children living in the household. There were two older females living in the household. Perhaps these were Clarissa's grandmothers. This can be investigated further in a future research session.

Analysis: In 1850, Clarissa Austin was two years old and living in the household of Tho<sup>s</sup> C. Austin and Harriet Austin. While the relationships are not provided, it can be inferred that that Clarissa and Isabella are the children of Thomas and Harriet.

## **Church Records**

Richard Whitney Loomis and Clara Louise Cowles were married in 1911 by Wm. Abbot Smith.<sup>54</sup> Rev. William Abbot Smith was the pastor of the Second Baptist Church in Suffield.<sup>55</sup> Records of the Second Baptist Church in Suffield do not appear in the list of Connecticut church records at the Connecticut State Library.<sup>56</sup> The Kent Memorial Library in Suffied, Connecticut, may be a source of further information about these records. An email inquiry has been sent to Second Baptist Church in Suffield but to date, no response has been received.<sup>57</sup>

Per the Clerk of the Court, that card is for the probate of William Cowles in 1945. There are no entries for Henry Cowles, Clara Cowles, or Clarissa Cowles.

Henry S. Cowles, 72 years old, for over 30 years one of the leading cigar box manufacturers of Massachusetts, died of heart disease recently at his home in Boston Neck, Suffield, Mass. Mr. Cowles was born in March 2, 1837, and during his younger years worked on his father's farm. On Dec. 15, 1859, he married Miss Clara Austin, daughter of the late T. Cornelius Austin, a descendant of one of the oldest settlers of the town. Mr. Cowles served as selectman for a number of years and was also a member of the board of relief. He attended the Second Baptist church. He leaves besides a widow, one brother, Frank Cowles of Hartford, five children, Mrs. A. A. Brown, George Cowles of Sacramento, Cal., Albert, Frank, and Miss Clara Cowles, all of Suffield.

ANALYSIS: The obituary of Henry S. Cowles names his daughter, Miss Clara Cowles. Clara appears under her maiden name, as she did not marry until the following year.<sup>58</sup>

married December 15, 1869, Clarissa K. Austin, daughter of the late T.C. Austin, and five children were born, all of whom are living: Jennie E., wife of A.A. Brown of Suffield, George Cowles of California and Albert B., Frank and Clara Louisa. He was for many years engaged in the manufacture of fine cut tobacco, and also ran a cigar box factory at the old homestead in Boston Neck. A number of years ago he sold out the tobacco business, and since then until his health failed had attended to the box factory. He was one of the oldest cigar-box makers in the state. In politics he was a democrat, and at different times held many town offices. The funeral will take place Wednesday at 2 o'clock from the house and burial will be in Woodlawn Cemetery.

ANALYSIS: This obituary provides a birth date of 02 March 1837 for Henry and names Clara Louisa as one of his daughters. The date of birth correlates with the date of birth provided in his marriage record as well as his death record.<sup>59</sup>

She attended the Connecticut Literary Institute, now Suffield academy. One of her ancestors, Stephen Austin, left Connecticut to help settle Texas and the town of Austin, Tex., was named for him.

Mrs Cowles leaves a daughter, Mrs Richard W. Loomis of Suffield; two sons, George of Sacramento, Cal., and Frank of Thompsonville; two brothers, Arthur and Cornelius of Suffield; 21 grandchildren, and 11 great-grandchildren.

ANALYSIS: The obituary of Clara A. Cowles names her as the daughter of Thomas C. and Harriet (Hatheway) Austin and the mother of Mrs. Richard Loomis. This information correlates with the register entry showing Clarissa K. Loomis as the child of Thomas Cornelius Austin and Harriet

ANALYSIS: Clara's obituary lists her as the widow of Richard W. Loomis and the daughter of Henry S. and Clara (Austin) Cowles. This correlates with the information from her birth and marriage records and provides further information that she was a member of Second Baptist Church, the same place where she had been married.<sup>62</sup>

ANALYSIS: This newspaper article about the fiftieth wedding anniversary of Richard Loomis and Clara Cowles names Mrs. Loomis' mother as Mrs. Henry Cowles of Boston Neck. This information does not conflict with any other sources reported.

ANALYSIS: Clara Louise Cowles is listed as the child of Henry S. Cowles and Clarissa K. Austin. Like *Genealogy of the Cowles families in America*, this source also provides a date of birth for Henry S. Cowles of 2 March 1838. Of note, the Cowles genealogy lists the King genealogy at the bottom of the entry, so one may have been sourced from the other. These authored works may not be independent sources, meaning that the information possibly came from the same origin.

## **Another Henry S. Cowles**

Records of another Henry S. Cowles, Civil War veteran from Connecticut, are available.<sup>66</sup> This Henry S. Cowles lived in East Hartford, was born approximately 1835, and likely died in 1903.<sup>67</sup> In 1860, Henry S. Cowles, age 25, a pattern maker, was enumerated in the household of Ashbel S. Cowles of East Hartford, Connecticut.<sup>68</sup> In 1902, Henry S. Cowles, patternmaker, resided at 11 Village, M, the Meadows section of East Hartford.<sup>69</sup> It is fairly straightforward to differentiate this man from Henry

S. Cowles of Suffield, the subject of this research, as the two men lived in different locations during the same time period and had different occupations.

## SUGGESTIONS FOR FURTHER RESEARCH

- Search land records of Suffield, Connecticut, for transactions naming Henry S. Cowles. These records are available in the Suffield Town Clerk's Office as well as digitally via FamilySearch, with access at a Family History Center or affiliate library.
- Review Tax Assessment Records available on Ancestry.com in the record group "U.S. IRS Tax Assessment Lists, 1862-1918" for entries for Henry S. Cowles.
- Learn about cigar box manufacturing, especially in the area of the Tobacco Valley of Connecticut, to provide background and context for the occupation of Henry S. Cowles. Resources may include Connecticut Valley Tobacco Museum inside Northwest Park in Windsor, Connecticut, as well as the book *Connecticut Valley Tobacco* by Brianna E. Dunlap, the museum's current President.
- Review the collection in the Suffield Historical Room at the Kent Memorial Library, Suffield, Connecticut. The collection includes but is not limited to published family histories, unpublished manuscripts, genealogical correspondence, more than one hundred account books of local farmers, letters, diaries, and military records.
- Search Springfield Republican newspaper for entries regarding the subject Cowles family. This newspaper is locally accessible at the Springfield City Library, Springfield, Massachusetts.
- After reviewing Suffield, Connecticut, land records, consult maps titled "Suffield" and "Suffield, Suffield West, West Suffield, Windsor Locks" published by Baker & Tilden in 1869 and currently available on Historic Map Works website. Identify locations of parcels owned by Henry S. Cowles. Overlay the map using the Historic Earth tool and determine the present-day location of these parcels of land.
- Review Suffield, Connecticut, *Town Ledger*, 1<sup>st</sup> School Society, 1871-1977, Office of the Town Clerk, Suffield, for entries concerning the subject family.
- Review "Records of cases of midwifery, 1827-1882," E.G. Ufford, LDS microfilm 185,373. Since this record appears to end in 1882, it will not be likely to locate Clara Louise Cowles, but it may contain records of her parents' births.
- Review the 1860 census for the household of Thomas C. Austin in Suffield, Connecticut. The two older women may be Clara's grandmothers.


